- Collaborate with the VP of Operations, Finance, IT, and cross-functional teams to ensure alignment, resolve issues, and finalize the Atlanta inventory transfer.
- Oversee the work of one partially assigned team member, escalate capacity constraints, and support solutions such as temporary labor when needed.
- Ensure accurate annual inventory counts by planning, preparing, physically conducting counts, and investigating discrepancies.

Requirements

- Strong hands-on capability and willingness to perform physical warehouse work, including lifting, moving stock, organizing racks, and operating a forklift if required.
